PRINCIPAL AGREEMENT : FOR IEEE RESEARCH PUBLICATIONS

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into between International Institute of Information Technology Bangalore (IIIT-B), Bengaluru, and Siddhartha Institute of Technology & Sciences (SITS), Narapally, Hyderabad, with the objective of promoting research activities and supporting IEEE research paper publications for students and faculty members.

The parties hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 – PURPOSE

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for academic and research collaboration between IIIT-B and SITS for the preparation, review, submission and publication of research papers in suitable IEEE conferences.

ARTICLE 2 – RESEARCH AND PAPER PREPARATION

Research topics will be identified and finalized in consultation with the concerned students and faculty members. Research papers will be prepared based on the finalized topics and relevant research work, following the applicable IEEE conference requirements.

The parties agree to:

- I. Encourage students and faculty members to participate in research activities.
- II. Support the preparation of research papers based on relevant research topics.
- III. Follow the applicable IEEE conference format and submission requirements.

ARTICLE 3 – ACADEMIC AND TECHNICAL SUPPORT

Necessary academic and technical guidance may be provided for research methodology, paper preparation and technical review. Required corrections and improvements will be incorporated before final submission.

ARTICLE 4 – QUALITY VERIFICATION

Research papers will undergo appropriate plagiarism/similarity verification and quality review before submission. The final papers will be prepared after incorporating the required corrections.

The quality verification process may include:

- I. Plagiarism/similarity verification.
- II. Technical and academic review.
- III. Formatting and documentation verification.

ARTICLE 5 – IEEE CONFERENCE SUBMISSION

The finalized research papers will be submitted to suitable IEEE conferences based on their scope, guidelines and submission requirements. The papers will be reviewed and finalized before submission to ensure compliance with the respective conference standards. The submission status and related communication will be coordinated with the concerned authors and institution. Acceptance of papers will be subject to the review process and policies of the respective IEEE conference.

ARTICLE 6 – CONFERENCE PARTICIPATION

Authors of accepted papers may participate in the respective IEEE conference through physical or approved online mode, depending on the conference requirements. Conference certificates and related documentation will be maintained by the concerned institution.

ARTICLE 7 – RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

IIIT-B may provide academic, technical and research-related guidance as mutually agreed. SITS will coordinate with students, faculty members and concerned departments for the smooth implementation of the publication activities.

ARTICLE 8 – FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Any expenses relating to research support, conference registration, publication, travel or other activities under this MoU shall be handled as mutually agreed between the parties and in accordance with the requirements of the respective IEEE conference.

ARTICLE 9 – INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

Authorship and institutional affiliations will be appropriately maintained in the research papers. Intellectual property rights relating to research work will be governed by the contributions of the respective authors and applicable institutional policies.

Both parties will maintain confidentiality regarding unpublished research data and information exchanged during the collaboration.



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ARTICLE 10 – DURATION, TERMINATION AND AGREEMENT

This MoU shall remain valid for a period of six (6) months from the date of signing, unless extended or terminated by mutual consent of both parties.

- I. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing written notice to the other party.
- II. Any amendment or modification to this MoU shall be made with the written consent of both parties.
- III. Both parties hereby agree to work together towards promoting IEEE research publications, academic research and student research activities under the terms of this MoU.
- IV. Submission of a research paper does not guarantee acceptance or publication, as the final decision rests with the respective IEEE conference and its review process.
